Someone once said; "No winter lasts forever and no spring skips its turn." The day the Lord created hope was probably the same day he created spring. And here it is. We see new life springing up in radiant colours.

We look forward to Easter which is meant to be a symbol of hope, renewal, and new life. And as Clarence W Hall said, if "Easter says anything to us today, it says this: You can put truth in a grave but it won't stay there."

Jesus came to show the way. He came to serve and to bring life to all who would believe. Jesus reshaped the world and brought about a great change.

As we journey through to the cross in this period of Lent, we find ourselves in an ever changing world. Two years ago, we faced Covid, lockdown, isolation, and our way of life changed forever.

Fast forward to today and we see the world is changed once more by the horrific war in Ukraine. We may feel hopeless at the sight of thousands of displaced people and the destruction that war brings. Jesus used this phrase as he was dying upon the cross. Jesus overcame death, three days later He rose to life in the power of the resurrection. HE IS ALIVE! Christ is risen – He is risen indeed. Hallelujah.

I'm hearing that the people of Ukraine have hope, they have a new light dawning in their pain. No winter lasts forever and neither can war.

I cannot describe the pain and anguish that I felt in the lives that I fought to

protect and save during the conflicts of Bosnia in the late 90's and Kosovo in early 2000. Though I wasn't a Christian at the time, I saw the immense power of God at work in ways that I see in the people of Ukraine. I think it all comes to this point, that Jesus Christ has the victory; death has been defeated once and for all.

Our times are in His hands. He will deliver from the hands of the enemies, from those that pursue. For He has restored and given hope for all. Hope for a future that will change our lives forever.

Therefore, let us hope for a brighter tomorrow. Let us hope for peace and for an end to this war. Let there be light for those sheltering in the darkness as they seek new life this spring. Amen.

Leading on from the previous articles on Christians and Climate Change, here are some practical ways in which you can help tackle poverty and also protect the environment.

Toilet Twinning - Flush Away Poverty

By donating £60 to twin your toilet, you help fund a project in a poor community that will enable families to build a basic toilet, have access to clean water and learn about hygiene – a vital combination that saves lives. Dignity is restored, especially for women and girls, when the whole family can use a private, hygienic toilet at their home and no longer have to squat in the bush.

When you twin, you will be sent a certificate to hang in your loo, showing a photograph of your overseas toilet twin and GPS coordinates so you can look up your twin's location on Google Maps!

Tap Twinning - Turn on Resources to Tackle Poverty

Today, 1 in 4 people lacks access to safe drinking water. By donating £60, you will help fund a project to provide sustainable, reliable and affordable access to safe, clean water in some of the world's poorest communities. In return, you will be sent a certificate to thank you for your support and show you an example of how your funds are being used.

Bin Twinning - Put a Lid on Poverty

2 billion people don't have their rubbish collected. By donating £45 to twin your bin, you help fund a community project that's preventing disease, protecting the environment and creating jobs.

When you twin, you will be sent a certificate to put on your kitchen bin or wheelie bin, showing a photo of the rubbish collection and recycling enterprise that you have twinned with overseas.

The children and young people stay in the main building at the start of the service for the time of sung worship, and then go out to our School Room building for their age-specific groups, where they engage with songs, bible teaching, crafts and other fun. The School Room is attached to the right-hand side of the main church.
